My life changed quickly and not in a way I would have chosen.

After serious health complications, I lost my leg and nearly my life. I had to learn how to rebuild in ways I never expected. Not just physically, but emotionally and spiritually too.

There were seasons where I did not feel confident or clear. I felt uncertain about who I was and what came next. Over time, I realized resilience is not about pushing through or reinventing yourself. It is about taking the next honest step and trusting that God is still leading you, even when the path looks different.

Today, I walk with women who are in that in-between place. Life shifted. The old plan no longer fits. And they are figuring out what comes next.

If that is you, you are not stuck. You are in process. And that process has purpose.

STEP 1: PAUSE

Before you rebuild, you must pause.

Not panic.

Not rush.

Not perform.

Pause.

Reflection Questions:

- Where in my life do I feel rushed or pressured right now?
- What feels heavy that I may not need to carry anymore?
- When was the last time I truly slowed down and listened?

Faith Reflection:

God often speaks in stillness.

- What might He be inviting you to notice in this season?

ACTIVATION:

Choose one small way to create space this week.

Five minutes of quiet.

A walk without your phone.

A journal entry before bed.

Stillness is not weakness. It is where clarity begins.

STEP 2: REFLECT

A comeback requires honesty.
Not shame.
Not regret.
Just clarity.

Reflection Questions:

- What has this season taught me about myself?
- What strengths have surfaced that I did not know I had?
- What patterns or habits no longer align with who I am becoming?

Faith Reflection:

- Ask: Lord, what are You forming in me right now?

ACTIVATION:

Write down three things you are stronger in today than you were one year ago.

Growth begins with honesty.





STEP 3: REFINE

You do not need to add more.
You may need to remove what no longer fits.

Refining is about alignment.

Reflection Questions:

- What truly matters in this season?
- What feels like obligation rather than calling?
- Where am I overcommitted?

Faith Reflection:

- Where is God asking you to trust Him instead of control the outcome?

ACTIVATION:

Identify one commitment, mindset, or expectation you are ready to release.

Share it with a someone, or go bold and share it online.

STEP 4: REBUILD

Rebuilding is not dramatic.
It is deliberate.

Small steps.
Consistent direction.
Rooted confidence.

Reflection Questions:

- What is one next faithful step I can take?
- What would rebuilding from strength look like instead of rebuilding from fear?
- Who do I need to become to walk confidently into this next season?

Faith Reflection:

You are not rebuilding alone.
God goes before you.

ACTIVATION:

Write one clear step you will take in the next seven days.
Keep it simple.

Small, faithful steps create powerful comebacks.
